

## Implementing Fundtrac at Partner Organisations Worldwide

The Church Development Service (EED) was founded in 1999. It serves as the central development organization of the Protestant Church in charge of coordination and implementation of all its relief efforts. Each year, the EED supports 300 projects and programs in Africa, Asia and Latin America, in Oceania, South-East Europe and the Caucasus.

The partners of the EED are churches, Christian organizations and Non-Christian support associations. The EED collaborates with them to provide a life in dignity to more people particularly in the least developed countries in the global South. The proliferation of justice, peace and the preservation of the Creation are its leading goals.
