CIWI GmbH supported the Water Foundation in the preparation and development of a project application for the German Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ). The objective of the project was to improve access to reserves of drinking water for poor communities in the mountainous areas of Eritrea in the Asmara region.



Over the course of the past years, the war and drought-stricken country increasingly had to fight against severe infra-structural challenges and develop innovative solutions to widespread shortages. The Water Foundation aims to improve the situation with the help of an approach that will make use of huge nets to “catch” fogs and thus render their contents of fresh drinking water available for human consumption.

Project Objectives

- Improvement of the supply in potable water to the villages of Nefasit and Arborobu
- Installation of 20 large and 10 small fog network facilities and construction of 3 storage tanks for drinking water in geographically promising locations

Project Scope

- Duration: October 2005 - February 2006
- Target groups encompass ~2.000 people from the highlands of the Maakel region
- Total project volume: 50.000.- €
